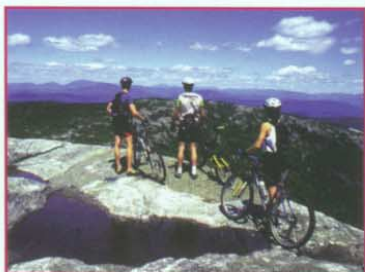


A GIFT FROM THOMAS EDISON, THIS ANTIQUE MARVEL STILL REMAINS AS IT DID IN 1924.

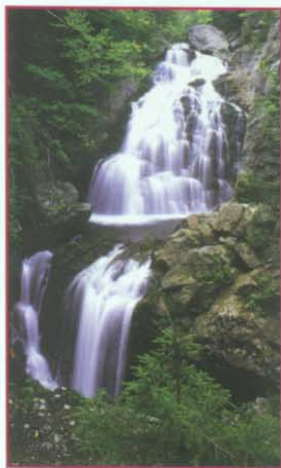

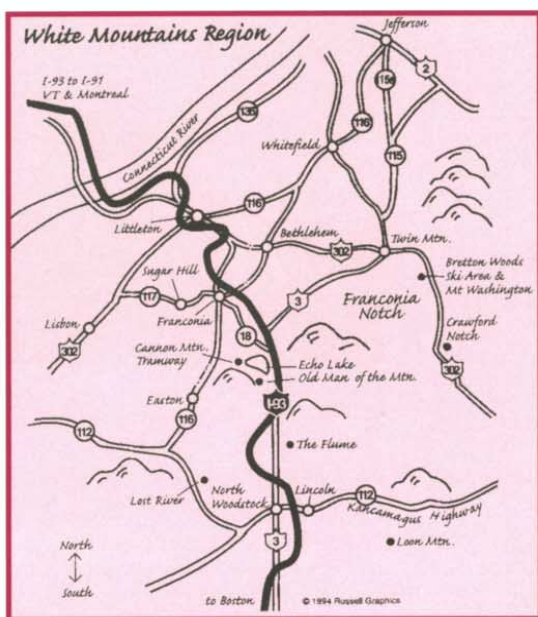

FROM BOSTON: I-93 North to Exit 40.

FROM HARTFORD, CT & NY: I-91 North Exit 17 in Vermont, take Route 302 East 31 miles, through Woodsville and Littleton, NH to Bethlehem.

FROM CANADA: I-91 South to I-93, South to NH to Exit 40.

OFF I-93 AT EXIT 40: Take Route 302 East 3 miles to Bethlehem. We are on the right.
